Brief Description of Work: Vessels will sail past the Nanaimo Yacht Club to salute the 2022 Commodore. Vessels will travel in a single line between Nanaimo Harbour and Departure Bay from North to South or South to North depending on the wind direction. Power boats will rendezvous in Mark Bay and sailboats in Departure Bay.
