**Brief Description of Work:** Nanaimo Yacht Club “SIN” Regatta will take place with approximately 30 sailboats participating. The start and finish area will be near Angle Point on Newcastle Island.

The sailboats will be racing SE of Protection Island and Newcastle Island. Snake Island, Five Fingers Island, Hudson Rocks may be in play. If conditions permit, some fleets may be sent to Halibut Bank buoy, around Entrance Island or north to Maude Island.

All efforts will be made to avoid crossing the course used by the ferry serving Nanaimo-Gabriola Island.
