

## **NOTICE TO INDUSTRY**

the Nanaimo Port Authority (NPA) navigable waters.

## **Details:**

Effective August 17<sup>th</sup>, 2020, in the interest of promoting safe and efficient navigation and environmental protection within the NPA navigable waters, the NPA requires ships - which are not engaged in commercial activity to - refrain from entering the area specified below:

**COMMENCING** at the LAT 49° 09.947′N, LONG 123° 54.988′W

**THENCE** southerly across to the point of intersection of the high water mark and the position at LAT 49° 09.720'N, LONG 123° 55.410'W

**THENCE** along the boundary of high water mark southerly, westerly, and northerly up to intersection of the high water mark and the position at LAT 49° 10.075'N, LONG 123° 55.950'W **THENCE** easterly, as the case may be, to the point of commencement.

For the purpose of this notice and the TCZ, a ship is defined by the *Canada Marine Act*, 1998, which means every description of vessel, boat or craft designed, used or capable of being used solely or partly for marine navigation, whether self-propelled or not and without regard to the method of propulsion, and includes a sea-plane and a raft or boom of logs or lumber.

NPA will make every effort to work co-operatively with the various agencies to ensure that the TCZ is maintained. The Port Authority will work collaboratively with its Port partners to minimize the impact on the surrounding community. Continuous NAVWARN broadcast will be issued congruently to make the boating community aware of this interim protocol.
