Subject: Temporary Relief - Nanaimo Anchorages Assignment Directive

Geographic Area: Nanaimo Harbour - Northumberland Channel

Communication: To provide relief in utilization of Nanaimo Port Authority Anchorages -

NA-01 through NA-06

Details:

Effective July 15, 2021, till further notice - in the interest of providing relief to the marine industry from the impacts of the wildfire situation affecting major railways in the B.C. interior, NPA will administer Anchorages as follows:

- NPA will revoke a ten-day maximum stay directive for its anchorages NA-1 through NA-6
- NPA will invoke a new extended stay directive of twenty-day maximum stay for its anchorages NA-1 through NA-6

Harbour dues will be payable on every vessel that enters the harbour at the following rates:

- Registered vessels, Gross registered tonnage, per GRT \$0.080
- Unregistered vessels, Gross tonnage as determined by the Harbour Master, per GRT \$0.080
- Minimum billing charges \$50.00

The NPA will reserve the following rights:

- The right to extend the vessel stay, with the stipulation that the full harbour dues will be payable, for any extensions granted.
- The right to request a vessel vacate its anchorage, in the event a vessel dwells for more than twenty days within the harbour limits.

Every effort will be made to work co-operatively with the various agencies to ensure equal access. NPA will work collaboratively with its port partners to minimize the impact on shippers, agents, terminal operators and greater community. The Harbour Master will be the sole approval authority on any extension requests, which will be considered on case by case basis.
