Port of Nanaimo advises the following:

The World Championship Bathtub Race will take place in Nanaimo Harbour on Sunday, July 24<sup>th</sup>, 2022, at 1100 (PDT).

The bathtub race will start from Nanaimo Harbour, proceeding to Entrance Island, NW to Winchelsea and then SE to Nanaimo Harbour. Ninety vessels are expected to participate.

All aviators are advised that Nanaimo Harbour Water Aerodrome "A" will be closed to all air traffic on July 24<sup>th</sup>, 2022, at 1000 (PDT) for the start of the race.

At 1130 (PDT) the North-end of Area A from abeam of the PS buoy in McKay Channel at 49° 10.351'N 123° 55.667'W to 49° 10.533'N 123° 55.667'W to 49° 10.533'N 123° 56.047'W to 49° 10.300'N 123° 55.945'W then back to 49° 10.351'N 123° 55.667'W will remain closed to air traffic. The Harbour Air RHIB and the NPA Osprey will escort aircraft to/from Aerodrome "A" and the seaplane base.

Aerodrome "A" will fully open at 1500 (PDT).

All aviators are to expect heavy surface traffic (HVY SFC TFC).
