Brief Description of Work: The Van Isle race committee will commence the Van Isle 360° Yacht Race in three starts, 1020, 1030 and 1040 in Nanaimo Harbour with 40 vessels and 350 people participating. Vessels will exit Nanaimo Harbour at Gallows Point proceed northbound to Neck Point and Comox. Vessels could be crossing traffic near the entrance to Departure Bay.

Nanaimo Harbour Water Aerodrome “A” will be closed to all seaplane and commercial traffic except for BC Ferries, Protection Island and Newcastle/Saysutshun Ferries between 1010 to 1100 hours.
